2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that websites place on your device (computer, smartphone, tablet) when you visit. They are widely used to make websites work efficiently, remember user preferences, and gather analytics data. Some cookies expire once you close your browser (“session cookies”), while others remain on your device until deleted or until they expire (“persistent cookies”).

3. Why We Use Cookies

We use cookies to:

1. Ensure the Website’s Functionality
 - Remember items in your shopping cart.
 - Keep you logged into your account in the Client Area.
 - Provide essential security measures.
2. Enhance User Experience
 - Store your preferences (e.g., language settings).
 - Personalize content or layout based on your usage patterns.
3. Analyze Performance and Usage
 - Gather aggregate data about site visits to improve our website’s performance, navigation, and content.
 - Identify and fix technical issues quickly.
4. Support Marketing Efforts (where applicable)
 - Track effectiveness of marketing campaigns.
 - Show relevant advertisements (with your consent, where legally required).

4. Types of Cookies We Use

1. **Strictly Necessary Cookies**

These cookies are essential for the operation of our website and services. They enable core functionalities such as security, network management, and accessibility. You cannot opt out of these cookies if you want the website to function properly.

2. **Functional Cookies**

These cookies help us remember your preferences and settings to provide an enhanced user experience. They are not strictly necessary but improve your user experience.

3. **Analytics/Performance Cookies**

We use these cookies to collect information about how you interact with our site—such as pages visited and links clicked—so we can optimize and improve our services. Data gathered is generally aggregated and anonymous.

4. **Marketing/Advertising Cookies**

These cookies track your browsing habits to deliver personalized advertising. They may also measure the effectiveness of ads. We only place marketing cookies on your device if you have provided explicit consent where required by law.

5. Third-Party Cookies

We may allow third parties (e.g., analytics or advertising partners) to place cookies on your device to collect information about your online activities over time and across different websites. Examples include, but are not limited to:

- Google Analytics (to analyze traffic and usage trends).
- Social media plugins (e.g., LinkedIn, X/Twitter, Instagram) that facilitate content sharing and engagement.

Third-party services have their own privacy policies and may use their cookies independently. We encourage you to review those policies for details on their data handling.

6. How to Manage or Disable Cookies

1. Browser Controls

Most web browsers allow you to delete, disable, or block cookies. Methods for doing this vary depending on the browser; check your browser's "Help" or "Settings" menu for instructions.

2. Cookie Banner or Pop-up

Upon your first visit (and periodically thereafter), we may display a cookie banner or pop-up to allow you to accept, customize, or reject certain categories of cookies.

3. Consent and Withdrawal

Where required by law, we obtain your prior consent for non-essential cookies. You can withdraw your consent at any time by adjusting your preferences through our cookie banner (when available) or by disabling cookies in your browser settings.

Please note that if you disable or reject certain cookies, parts of our website or services may become unavailable or not function properly.

7. Data Collection and Privacy

We may collect personal data via our cookies or similar technologies. Any personal data collected will be handled in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#) (URL to be inserted).

- **Purpose of Processing:** To optimize site performance, provide personalized experiences, and enable core functionalities.
- **Legal Basis:** Consent for non-essential cookies (where applicable), and our legitimate interests or contractual necessity for strictly necessary cookies and related functionalities.
